

1. Introduction

Welcome to Tshwane Technical Institution. We are delighted to have this opportunity to support you in your effort to successfully accomplish your academic goals at Tshwane Technical Institution. This bursary covers 50% of the student monthly Tuition Fees

2. Who is Eligible?

Tshwane Technical Institution's Bursary scheme is available to South African citizens who meet prescribed eligibility criteria.

The various eligibility criteria are set out below.

Academic Eligibility

- Students who have received an **acceptance letter** or **proof of registration** of admission at Tshwane Technical Institution to study NATED Engineering Studies (**N4-N6**) or NATED Business and Utility Studies (**N4-N6**).
- **Full time Students** who will be attending Classes Monday to Friday.
- Students intending to complete their N6 studies at Tshwane Technical Institution.
- Students that will register a minimum of four subjects per trimester or semester.

NEW STUDENTS / REGISTRATION

A. ENGINEERING STUDIES

- You must have achieved a minimum of 45% in Mathematics, Physical Sciences and English or
- Must have passed **THREE** NATED subjects from the previous level with a minimum of 50% in Mathematics N3 – N5, Engineering Science N3 – N4 and Power Machines N5.
- For Civil Engineering Studies, a minimum of 50% must have been achieved in Building Science N3, Building Drawing N3, Quantity Survey N4-N5 & Building and Structural Construction N4-N5.

B. BUSINESS AND UTILITY STUDIES

- You must have achieved a minimum of 50% in English or
- Must have passed **THREE** NATED subjects from the previous level with a minimum of 50% in not less than 2 subjects.

CONTINUING STUDENTS

C. ENGINEERING STUDIES AND BUSINESS AND UTILITY STUDIES

Continuing students must be registered for the relevant academic year and must satisfy the minimum progression requirements of Tshwane Technical Institution, which are as follows:

1. The student must have passed a minimum of 3 subjects in the previous level.
2. The student must have obtained at least 50% or plus in not less than 2 subjects of that previous level.
3. The student should continue to study on a full time basis.

DO STUDENTS HAVE TO REPAY THIS BURSARY UPON COMPLETION OF THEIR STUDIES?

No, unlike a student loan, Tshwane Technical Institution's bursary is **NOT** repayable

3. STUDENT OBLIGATIONS

The student shall satisfy all the obligations described below to remain eligible for Tshwane Technical Institution's 50% bursary scheme:

The bursary awarded student shall:

- Attend and participate in lectures, tutorials and academic support programmes as required by Tshwane Technical Institution.
- Attend a minimum of **90%** of classes per trimester or semester because **regular student absenteeism will lead to immediate termination of the bursary scheme**. If you are absent due to illness or hospitalization, you must provide a doctor's letter upon your return.
- Undergo all tests and internal examinations as by the Department of Higher Education and Training, to qualify for the final Examinations
- Pass with a minimum percentage of 50% for two or more modules in your trimester or semester of study.

4. CANCELLATION OF BURSARY

Tshwane Technical Institution's 50% bursary is subject to termination if any of the terms and conditions stated above (**student obligations**) are breached by the bursary beneficiary.

5. PROVISION OF INFORMATION

- The student agrees to provide Tshwane Technical Institution with true, accurate and complete information and documentation required for the assessment of the Application Form and for any other purpose of the Agreement.
- Where it can be proved that the student has intentionally submitted untrue or incorrect information to Tshwane Technical Institution, the College may institute criminal and/or civil proceedings against the student and/or the student's parent/s or legal guardian/s.

6. DATA PROTECTION

Tshwane Technical Institution undertakes to ensure that it respects and maintains the privacy and confidentiality of any personal information and data that it may obtain or gain access to and in particular undertakes that it will not process any of the student's personal information without his/her prior written consent.
